**Parent Reminder:
2nd dose for children age nine years and under available**

HOWELL, Michigan (December 1, 2009) The Livingston County Department of Public Health (LCDPH) has an important reminder for parents: This season children ages six months through nine years old will need two doses of the H1N1 vaccine preferably 30 days apart. We are now taking appointments for children needing their second dose.

Livingston County Department of Public Health has **afternoon or evening appointments available throughout December** for the Priority Groups listed below. Call (517) 546-9850 for an appointment.

- Pregnant women,
- Persons aged 6 months to 24 years old,
- Persons who living with or provide care for infants aged less than 6 months (e.g., parents, siblings, and daycare providers),
- Persons aged 25 to 64 years who have medical conditions that put them at higher risk for influenza-related complications,
- Health care and emergency medical services personnel workers who have direct contact with patients,
- Children age nine and under who received their first dose of H1N1 vaccine at least 30 days ago.
