



Cosmetology

Program Description

This two-year program in cosmetology provides training and opportunities to work in a salon with real customers. Besides hair styling and hair care, other areas covered include skin care, nail services, and artificial hair. A heavy dose of math and science supporting salon work is included. Cosmetology students must be motivated, disciplined, able to work in a group, have an aptitude for science and math, and have strong communication skills. Also, the program is competitive, taking only 10-12 students per year. Brighton Institute helps to educate students with the process of earning their State of Michigan Cosmetology License.

The program is provided by the Brighton Institute of Cosmetology and is available for students enrolled at Brighton, Fowlerville, Hartland, Howell, or Pinckney High Schools. Students/families are responsible for partial tuition costs. Students are expected to attend school during the summer to meet the required industry hours for their license.
