This course enhances technical, communication, and problem solving skills as they relate to the study of Information Security and Information Assurance. Hands-on lab and virtual learning tools will help students develop critical thinking and complex problem-solving skills. This is a year-long course - the first semester provides an introduction to computer hardware and software skills. The second semester of this course introduces the architecture, structure, functions, components, and models of the Internet and networks. The skills developed in the course help students meet the growing demand for entry-level information and communication technology (ICT) professionals, as well as begin to prepare them to pursue their CCNA certification.
