Program Description

All Health Occupation classes include a core curriculum that covers medical terminology, CPR, first aid and anatomy. First year students in the Health Occupations class will gain skills that can be applied in any health care specialty that will be valuable throughout their career. Students learn in the classroom and experience a variety of careers in the health field through clinical rotations. All health careers require a basic knowledge of medical terminology, vital signs and certifications in CPR and first aid. This class covers all that, plus universal precautions, anatomy, physiology, people skills and more.

After completing health occupations, students are eligible to enroll in the Emergency Medical Technician (EMT) program.
