Program Description

Air Force JROTC offers many opportunities and choices to students, with a Shared Campus opportunity available.

Students begin with Aerospace Science Survival, which provides training in skills, knowledge, and attitudes necessary to successfully perform fundamental tasks needed for survival.

As students advance to Leadership Education, Life Skills, and Career Opportunities, they are prepared for life after high school in the high-tech, globally oriented, and diverse workplace of the 21st-century. Students will learn how to save, invest, and spent money wisely, as well as how to avoid credit traps. They learn about real-life issues such as shopping, apartment selection, and life with roommates.

In addition, students learn how to select a school that is right for them; how to apply for admission to a vocational or technical school, community college, or college/university; and how to succeed in these learning environments. Information is provided on how to conduct the job search for students who wish to enter the workforce right after high school or after additional education and training. They learn how to prepare a winning resume, and how to develop effective interviewing skills. Military, aerospace, and public service careers are all explored.
